- Identify a Senate Champion to carry permitting reform bill.
- Develop talking points/narrative around reliability/resource adequacy "all of the above."
- Engage in the R-STEP program process.

## Strategies & Tactics:

- Deliver on 2024 strategic plan.
- Build more efficient communication and coordination with ACP, Lobby team, AEU, other on the ground stakeholders.
- Convene regular working group calls throughout the remainder of the year.
- Look for opportunities to place positive messaging through earned media (Strategic Elements).
- Agree on policy framework in September.
- Continue good old fashion on the ground relationship building in Indianapolis.
